S. Lewis and Tolkien as you dine where they and the other *Inklings* gathered to share their latest manuscripts, traverse the winding staircase of a 1000 year old Saxon Castle, and breath in the steam of a 2000 year old Roman Bath, among many other unforgettable experiences.
